Dear Parent/Guardian:

Math, science, and technology play a major role in our lives today. The North Country Science and Technology Entry Program (NCSTEP) would like to encourage your child's interest in these fields through academic support services and enrichment activities. NCSTEP will help to support your child throughout his/her middle and high school years and to see him/her continue to a post-secondary education in the fields of math, science, technology, engineering, health, or the licensed professions.

NCSTEP serves approximately 300 students in the Canton, Madrid-Waddington, Massena, Parishville-Hopkinton, and Salmon River school districts, as well as SLL-BOCES. Our goal is to increase the number of historically underrepresented and income eligible students prepared to enter college in majors involving math, science, technology, engineering, health related fields and the licensed professions. To be eligible to participate in NCSTEP, students must be historically underrepresented in STEM careers or licensed professions (American Indian/Alaskan Native, African American, Hispanic/Latino) or meet economic guidelines (see below).
