

A concentration is a grouping of courses (generally 12-15 credit hours) designed to allow the student to emphasize a specific area of study, similar to a minor. These courses may fall within the credit hour requirements of the student's degree program.

Music technology now infuses every aspect of professional musicianship. The Music Technology Concentration is designed for music majors who wish to signify their technology interest and expertise to future employer and extend their work with music technology, regardless of their major.

The Concentration in Music technology can be added by any music major. The supervisor for the program is Dr. Peter McCoy.
