

A concentration is a grouping of courses (generally 12-15 credit hours) designed to allow the student to emphasize a specific area of study, similar to a minor. These courses may fall within the credit hour requirements of the student's degree program.

This concentration is open to all music majors with approval of the Coordinator of Piano Pedagogy, Dr. Kathryn Sherman.
