Concentration in Special Music Education

A concentration is a grouping of courses (generally 12-18 credit hours) designed to allow the student to emphasize a specific area of study, similar to a minor. These courses may fall within the credit hour requirements of the student's degree program. This concentration is open to all music majors with approval of the Coordinator of the concentration.
