

2024-2025 Musical Theatre Minor

This minor is under review.

A minor is a grouping of courses (generally around 21 credit hours) designed to allow the student to emphasize a specific area of study. These courses may fall within the credit hour requirements of the student's degree program.

The Musical Theatre minor may be pursued only by students who have declared a major in music.

The minor may not be completed without acceptance through the audition/interview process. The audition/interview will include a short monologue, a song, an example of movement, and a conversation with faculty. Auditions/interviews will be scheduled in February each year, with criteria for acceptance clearly defined. Students will be allowed a maximum of two attempts if not successful the first time. The audition/interview panel will consist of one faculty member from each area, theatre, dance, and music.
